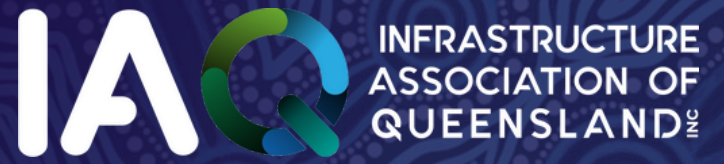

CORPORATE TIER 1

\$4,500 (incl. GST) annual

Predominantly private organisations working in the infrastructure sector with 11+ employees.

CORPORATE TIER 2

\$2,250 (incl. GST) annual

Predominantly private organisations working in the infrastructure sector with 2-10 employees.

ASSOCIATE MEMBER

\$3,500 (incl. GST) annual

Government entities and government-owned corporations associated with the infrastructure sector.

INDIVIDUAL MEMBER

\$990 (incl. GST) annual

Single directors, sole traders or individuals in the sector who are not employed by an organisation with 2 or more employees.

Price increases for membership fees are in line with previous practice and reflect rising costs after two years without adjustment

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the membership period?

1 January – 31 December annually

What type of membership should I apply for?

- If you are a private company with 11 or more employees, please apply for a Corporate Tier 1 membership
- If you are a private company with 2-10 employees, please apply for a Corporate Tier 2 membership
- If you are a single director entity or sole trader who is not employed by a larger organisation, please apply for an Individual membership
- If you are a non-private organisation, eg. a government entity, government-owned corporation, educational institution, please apply for an Associate membership

What are the annual membership fees? (incl. GST)

- Corporate Tier 1 membership \$4,500
- Corporate Tier 2 membership \$2,250
- Individual membership \$990
- Associate membership \$3,500

When will I receive my renewal notice and invoice?

Early December

I am interested in joining IAQ, when can I apply?

Applications are accepted all year round.

Under what circumstances can I apply for a pro-rata rate to membership fees?

A 50% pro-rata rate will be applied to all applications past 30 June

How do I apply for membership?

- Pay your membership fee (payment options include EFT and credit card. Details are on the invoice)
